AALO Energy Program was presented to a large group of people at the **Greater Community Missionary Baptist Church** in Pacoima.

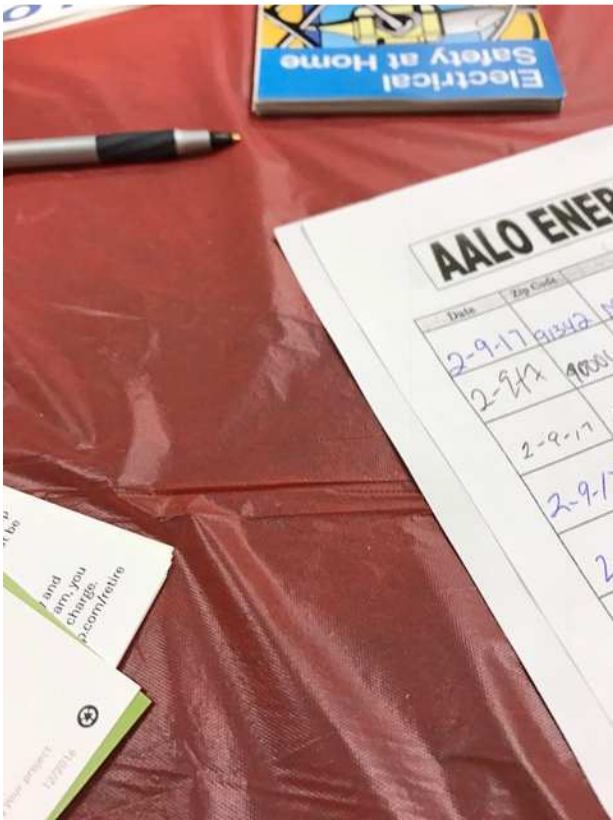

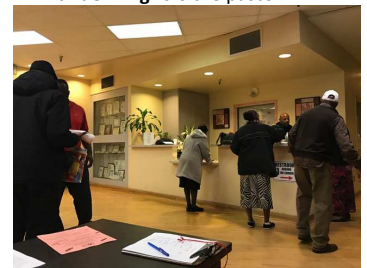
## AALO Energy Efficiency Program
