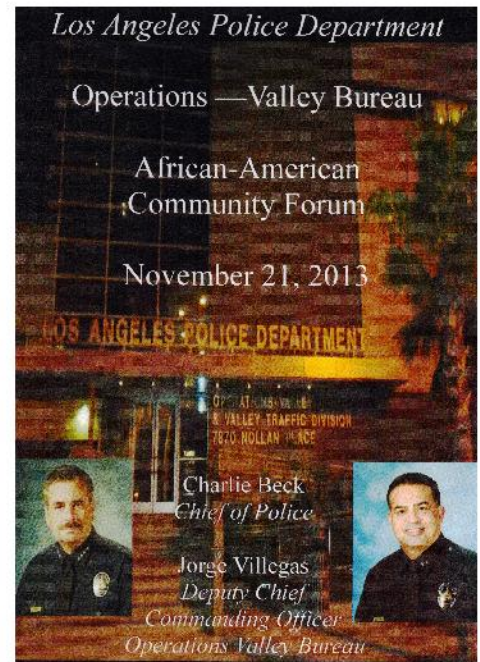


LAPD African American Forum
