We are grateful for the support that the community and elected officials have given MCCN to make this construction possible!"

The new facility will be 19,800 square feet of clinic space. Medical and behavioral health clinics will be located on level 2 and level 3 will house a dental clinic and administrative offices. The building will be completed in February 2015.
