Covered CA Open Enrollment Ends

April 2014

Background

Covered California is a state-designed program to make it simple and affordable for you to purchase high-quality health insurance and access financial assistance to pay for coverage. You can shop online, over the phone or in person to find the right health care insurance option for you. Through Covered California, both individuals and small businesses can compare different health insurance plans. Covered CA began the enrollment process in October 2013 and enrollment ended on April 15.

Special Enrollment

You may still enroll for coverage if you have what is called a "qualifying life event" such as marriage, the birth of a child, etc. You can visit the Covered California website for more information. (www.coveredca.com)

MediCal Enrollment

Medi-Cal offers free or low-cost health coverage for California residents who meet eligibility requirements. Most individuals who apply through Covered California and enroll in Medi-Cal will receive services through managed care health plans, similar to the majority of the health coverage options available through Covered California

MCCN Certified Enrollment Counselors (CEC)

Providing opportunities for the community to get coverage during the ACA enrollment period, MCCN had our own **Certified Enrollment Counselors** available to enroll people at our clinic locations and at various locations within the community including grocery stores, libraries and churches.

Starting out with only six CECs to cover all of our clinic locations and community locations, MCCN eventually increased the number of trained enrollment specialists to 13. Here's what one of the counselors had to say:

"During the enrollment period we grew closer as a team and also with our community. In the short amount of time we were able to successfully enroll over a hundred people. With the acquired skills developed during this first enrollment period we will be able to continue and assist individuals and families in the future."
